Are you worried about your child's hearing?

Permanent childhood hearing loss is actually quite rare.

Around 1 to 2 babies in every 1000 are born with a hearing loss in one or both ears. Most babies have their hearing tested shortly after birth.

However, temporary hearing problems are very common in childhood. Many factors can contribute including coughs, colds and ear infections.
